

BLUE RIDGE CONDINIUM POOL RULES

June 16, 2020

The following rules apply for the usage of the outdoor pool by Blue Ridge Residents, in accordance with the Executive Orders of Governor Andrew Cuomo and the Suffolk County Department of Health.

1. No more than 85 people total will be allowed to occupy the pool/pool area at any given time. Pool Monitors will be responsible for ensuring that this total is not exceeded.
2. Residents using the pool must show their Blue Ridge ID card to enter the pool area.
3. Residents using the pool must wear the pool bracelet received from the pool monitor at the time of check-in.
4. All residents must have their temperature taken by the pool monitor, using a non-invasive scanning thermometer, before entering the pool area,.
5. Each resident using the pool must bring his or her own chair to sit on in the pool area and remove the same at the end of his or her pool time.
6. All residents must wear a mask at the time of check-in with the pool monitor and must wear the same until seated in the pool area. Masks must also be worn when exiting the pool area.
7. All residents must maintain a 6' social distance between themselves and other residents both in and out of the pool.
8. All residents must exit the pool area during closing times.
9. No guests will be allowed in the pool area at the present time.
10. In addition to the above Covid-19 Rules, all usual pool rules must be followed.

Hours of operation:

Daily from 10:00 AM – 12:00 noon, 1:00 PM -3:00 PM and 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM

Sanitary Procedures:

All common and frequently touched surfaces in the pool area, as well as bathrooms, will be cleaned and sanitized during each break in the hours of operation (12:00 noon -1:00 PM; 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM).

NOTE: The failure of Blue Ridge Residents to comply with these rules, in violation of the Executive Orders of Governor Andrew Cuomo and the Suffolk County Department of Health will result in the closure of the pool.
